

R/1/2 Class- Term 2 2018

This year is flying by for the R/1/2 class! The new Reception students have settled in well to the school environment and all students in the class have made huge progress since the start of the school year. All students in the class are looking forward to the learning ahead in Term 2:

Literacy:

Students will practise readers and learn sight/spelling words at school/home and will participate in weekly guided reading lessons with activities based on texts and comprehension skills. Students will take part in a spelling/sight word test every Friday. The genre writing focus for Term 2 will be on narrative. Formal handwriting lessons will occur each week with emphasis on pencil grip, direction, size, neatness and letters sitting on lines. Each week your child will participate in sharing on a given topic to the class as well as presenting work to the class on a regular basis. Reception students will continue the Jolly Phonics program.

Maths:

Reception: Represent practical situations to model addition and sharing, copy, continue and create patterns, describe position and movement and sort, describe and name 2D and 3D shape.

Year 1: Skip counting by 2, 5 and 10, read and order numbers to 100, fractions including halves, quarters, eighths, ordering and naming money, problem solving and naming and describing 2D and 3D shape through drawing and classifying.

Year 2: Skip counting by 2, 5 and 10, read order and write numbers to 1000, fractions including halves, quarters, eighths, ordering and naming money, problem solving and naming and describing 2D and 3D shape through drawing and classifying.

Science: In term 2 students will be investigating Earth and Space Sciences with a particular focus on weather.

History: The focus for history in Term 2 will be on the local community.
