



BUSHFIRE EVACUATION CONTINGENCY PLAN 2021

As our school is in a recognised bushfire zone the following plan will remain in force until the official end of the danger season as decreed by the Country Fire Service.

In the event of the Kangarilla area being threatened by bushfire:

- All children will remain with their class teacher, collect their bags, fill water bottles and remain actively engaged in their classrooms. Should this period of danger occur during NIT then the children WILL return to their classroom with their class teacher. The Principal or nominee will decide if and when it is necessary to “invacuate” into the last resort refuge room which is the main school building (the assembly room).
- **NO CHILD will be dismissed unless written permission has been given.**
- Evacuation from the school to another safe area will only occur under Police and/or CFS instruction.

PLEASE NOTE – This only gives permission for the nominated person to collect your child in a Bushfire Emergency if you as the parent decide that it is your wish.

All children not collected from school will be supervised by staff and in most situations will stay at school.

Staff and students from the school will only evacuate from the site if it is deemed necessary by the CFS or SAPOL

Students will only be allowed to leave the school in a Bushfire emergency if

1. A parent collects them
2. The nominated adult on the form personally collects them

This includes children who under normal circumstances catch the School Bus home.
